What is Mission to Unreached Peoples? We are an interdenominational, evangelical Christian ministry with a clearly defined strategic focus of reaching the last remaining unreached people groups of the world with the transforming, life-giving gospel of Jesus Christ.

What is an Unreached People Group (UPG)? An unreached or least-evangelized people is an ethno-linguistic people group which has *no access* or *almost no access* to see or hear the Gospel within their own culture. At present there are 6,000 plus such UPGs in the world amounting to over 1.8 billion people or 27.9% of the world’s population.

How does MUP serve Unreached People Groups? MUP joins with Great Commission Christians (GCCs), churches, and ministries across the globe to equip, send, and support “Strategy Teams” who prayerfully and strategically serve among UPGs. Our goal is to stimulate transformational *church planting movements* among many UPGs- and to help other GCCs to catalyze movements among other UPGs as well.

What does a Church Planting Movement look like? A CPM is a rapid multiplication of reproducing congregations which plant reproducing congregations in a way that sweeps through a people group or population segment. Whole households are disciplined together to obey *all* that Jesus commanded through immediately serving their community. They are guided by the authority of Scripture and the power of the Holy Spirit to share the Gospel in word, deed and miracle. Groups that do not serve the community and do not reproduce are not considered viable churches.

What is a Strategy Team? A strategy team consists of 2-6 people who follow the Holy Spirit and collaborate with GCCs, churches and ministries across the globe to create and implement a specially customized set of strategies that is intentional in its focus on stimulating a CPM. These strategies would prioritize massive prayer focus, and abundant living out the Gospel in word and deed.

How can my Church and I get involved? You and your church can:

- Partner with an existing team as intercessors, financial supporters, and advocates for specific UPGs, or
